From our new Greens Chair:

Man-hour estimate for greens maintenance for the 2017 season:

- Cutting and Verticutting – 1188 hours
- Rolling the green – 120 hours

At least we can guess that approximately 200 man hours were spent on the tree and fungus growth (plugging bad spots, replacing turf under the tree, hand scapping fungus spots).

This does not take into consideration the time spent on the maintenance of the machinery that Vern has done nor the amount of time watering and fertilizing, and maintaining the surround. A guess on this would be approximately 120 hours. At a wage of \$15.00 an hour this is equivalent to \$24,420.
